**lunes**

● Trabajo el **lunes**.

→ I work on Monday.

2



**martes**

● El **martes** tengo examen.

→ I have an exam on Tuesday.

3



**miércoles**

● **Miércoles** es mi día favorito.

→ Wednesday is my favorite day.

4



**jueves**

● Salimos el **jueves** por la noche.

→ We go out Thursday night.

5



**viernes**

● El **viernes** termina la semana laboral.

→ Friday ends the work week.

6



**sábado**

● Descanso el **sábado**.

→ I rest on Saturday.

7



**domingo**

● El **domingo** visitamos a la familia.

→ We visit family on Sunday.

# IMPORTANT GRAMMAR RULES FOR WEEK DAYS IN SPANISH



1

el

## Use "el" with singular days.

When you talk about one specific day, use "el" before the day.

Example:

**El lunes** tengo una reunión.  
*I have a meeting on Monday.*

2

los

## Use "los" for repeated actions.

When the action happens every week on that day, use "los".

Example:

**Los viernes** salimos a cenar.  
*We go out for dinner on Fridays.*

abc

## Days are not capitalized.

In Spanish, days of the week are not capitalized.

Example:

**Incorrect:** Lunes ✗  
**Correct:** lunes ✓

4

en

## No "on" before the day.

Spanish does not use "on" (en) before days.

Example:

**Incorrect:** en lunes ✗  
**Correct:** el lunes ✓

5



## Use prepositions for clarity.

Use "de" to say "of" and "para" to say "for" with days.

Example:

- Reunión **el martes** = Meeting on Tuesday
- Clase **de inglés el jueves** = English class on Thursday
- Estudio **para el examen el domingo** = I study for the exam on Sunday
