Inform someone officially.

Examine or review carefully.

No longer like or need something.

Love and value deeply.

Think someone is not important.

Compensate for a mistake.

Leave your home for social activities.
-  **Give up**  
Stop trying or surrender.
-  **Write down**  
Write something on paper.
-  **Turn on**  
Start a machine or device.
-  **Turn off**  
Stop a machine or device.
-  **Go back**  
Return to where you were before.
-  **Pick up**  
Collect or lift something.
-  **Send off**  
Send someone or something away.
-  **Talk over**  
Discuss something with someone.
-  **Cheer up**  
Become happier or more positive.
-  **Hang out**  
Spend time with friends.
-  **Fill in**  
Write information in a form or document.
-  **Put off**  
Delay or postpone something.
-  **Figure out**  
Understand or solve a problem.
-  **Carry on**  
Continue doing something.
