Types of B Nouns

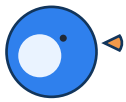
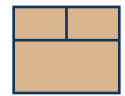
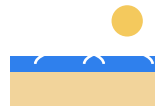
Learn the noun type, then scan the examples.

Common noun	general name boy, bird, bridge
Proper noun	specific name Brazil, Bangkok
Concrete noun	can be sensed ball, bottle, banana
Abstract noun	idea or quality beauty, bravery, belief
Countable noun	can be counted book, bag, biscuit
Uncountable noun	usually a mass bread, blood, butter
Compound noun	two words form one noun bedroom, bookshelf, backpack

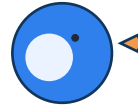
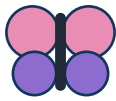

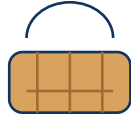
