

Structure of Positive Sentences

Sentence Pattern	Structure
Simple Present	Subject + base verb(s/es)
Simple Past	Subject + past verb
Simple Future	Subject + will + base verb
Present Continuous	Subject + am/is/are + verb-ing
Past Continuous	Subject + was/were + verb-ing
Present Perfect	Subject + has/have + past participle
Past Perfect	Subject + had + past participle
With “Be”	Subject + am/is/are + complement
With Modal Verb	Subject + can/may/should + base verb
